







Important information for I'll Be Your Mirror Patrons Transport, Times, Food & Drink And More!

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY

Thank you for purchasing tickets to All Tomorrow's Parties I'll Be Your Mirror London festival!

Tickets have now been dispatched to all UK ticketholders - if you booked from overseas you will be collecting your tickets at the box office when you arrive at the event - if you have a problem or need more details please contact the ticket agency you booked through.

When you arrive your tickets will be exchanged for a wristband (giving you access either to the whole weekend or to one day depending on what tickets you have purchased), which will allow re-entry throughout the day/event should you need it. The main entrance / ticket exchange & collection point will be the Palm Court entrance (see map below).

If you have already got your physical tickets and wish to speed your entry at the weekend, ATP staff will be doing early wristbanding at Rough Trade East, 'Dray Walk', Old Truman Brewery, 91 Brick Lane, London E1 6QL on Wednesday 23rd May from 1pm-8pm. Please bring your tickets and booking reference information. Wristband exchange will also open early from 2pm at the venue on the day.

Please note lost wristbands cannot be replaced so please be careful not to lose them!

TIMES

Doors will open at 4pm Friday and midday on Saturday and Sunday, with the event finishing at 12 midnight on all three nights. Slaver, Mogwai and The Afghan Whigs will all finish by 11pm each night. We will be providing shuttle buses to and from Wood Green which will be running from around 4pm to the last tube on Friday and around 7.30pm to the last tube on Saturday and Sunday (around midnight). Please note this service is limited and there are public transport options also available, see details below.

FOOD & DRINK

Bringing in food and drink from outside is not permitted. Don't forget to check out the fabulous food vendors at the event, they will be in the Food Court all weekend and will include:

If you want to smoke, please avoid where people are eating so others aren't inconvenienced – re-admittance is allowed with your festival wristband so there is plenty of outdoor space for this event.

EARPLUGS

Please note that ticketholders may be subjected to continuous sound levels, which may cause damage to hearing - ATP recommends the use of earplugs.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

Under 14s must be accompanied by an adult, under 5s are admitted free. Under 10s must be out of the venue by 8pm. Please make sure young children use ear protection! Please keep an eye on the film classifications, which are listed next to each film on the website and timecards.

ILLEGAL DRUGS / WEAPONS

No illegal substances or weapons (or other illegal items) may be brought onto or taken on the premises. Anyone caught in possession of such items will be ejected from the premises and reported to the police.

TRANSPORT

There are a number of ways to travel to and from Alexandra Palace. Please check www.tfl.gov.uk before travelling for full details - if you're in London, using the venue's postcode (N22 7AY) on that site will show you some possible routes & methods of travel. Please also see the Map image below to give you a better idea of the venue's location.

Trains:

Overground trains (B.R.) run from Kings Cross and Finsbury Park to Alexandra Palace station and back. We recommend this as the quickest and closest method. Up to date train times can be found at: www.nationalrail.co.uk - note trains only run from Old Street and Moorgate up until about 9.30pm.

Underground:

The closest tube station is Wood Green. When you arrive at Wood Green, cross the road and go to bus stop A (opposite the station) and board the W3, which will take you straight to Alexandra Palace.

Buses:

ATP is providing a Shuttle Service to and from the venue and Wood Green at peak times across the weekend (4pm-last tube Friday, and from 7.30pm-last tube on Saturday and Sunday). Please note there is a small fee of £1 from Wood Green to the venue, but from the Palace back to Wood Green it will be free. The bus will only run at peak times and may have limited capacity - you may need to take the London bus W3 service instead.

When arriving in Wood Green, the shuttle stop is on Station Road (south side), west of Wood Green High Road. Bus stop number (there is a plate under the flag) BP4262. When exiting Wood Green Station cross over the main road and walk as if you are going up the

hill to A.P. - the first bus stop you come to has 'Special Service' on it. This is the dedicated stop. It is highlighted on the map below.

When leaving the venue, at the West end of the Palace is the 'Palm Court Entrance', in front of which is a semi circular pull-in where the buses arrive to take people back to Wood Green

If you leave late and need night buses, the N29 & N91 from Wood Green go via Kings Cross and end in Trafalgar Square, and the 243 goes via Shoreditch to Waterloo. Alternatively from nearby Muswell Hill the 43 goes via Archway to London Bridge and the 134 via Archway & Camden Town to Tottenham Court Road.

Taxi:

Parking:

There is free Parking at Alexandra Palace - available on a first come first served basis - but we do recommend you use public transport!

The event takes place almost exclusively inside, but there will be plenty of outdoors things to do too, weather permitting.

PITCH AND PUTT

Just over the road from Alexandra Palace towards the station is a 10 hole Pitch and Putt. If you show your wristband you are eligible for a round including hire of clubs and balls for the discounted price of $\pounds 6$. The Pitch and Putt is open from 9:15am-nightfall and takes around an hour and a quarter.

LAKESIDE BOATS, ALEXANDRA PALACE

If you keep the Palace on your left and walk past the ice rink and down the hill you will come to Lakeside Boats where showing your wristband will give you a 10% discount on all boat hire. Boats cost between £4.50 and £5 per person per half and hour and include rowing boats and Swan pedalo's. Open from 11am - 5:30pm
